

Your safety and the safety of others are very important.

ADANGER

IMPORTANT SAFEGUARDS

When using electrical appliances, basic safety precautions should always be followed, including the following:

- **1.** Read all instructions. Misuse of appliance may result in personal injury.
- **2.** To protect against risk of electrical shock, do not put Blender in water or other liquid.
- 3. This appliance is not intended for use by persons (including children) with reduced physical, sensory or mental capabilities, or lack of experience and knowledge, unless they have been given supervision or instruction concerning use of the appliance by a person responsible for their safety.
- **4.** European Union Only: This appliance shall not be used by children. Keep the appliance and its Cord out of reach of children.

- 5. European Union Only: Appliances can be used by persons with reduced physical, sensory or mental capabilities or lack of experience and knowledge if they have been given supervision or instruction concerning use of the appliance in a safe way and understand the hazards involved.
- **6.** Children should be supervised to ensure they do not play with the appliance.
- 7. Avoid contacting moving parts. Keep hands, hair, clothing, as well as spatulas and other utensils away from Blade during operation to reduce the risk of injury to persons and/or damage to the Blender.
- 8. Turn the appliance off (O), then unplug from the outlet when not in use, before assembling or disassembling parts and before cleaning. To unplug, grasp the plug and pull from the outlet. Never pull from the Power Cord.
- **9.** Do not operate any appliance with a damaged cord or plug, or after the appliance malfunctions, or is dropped or damaged in any manner. Return appliance to the nearest Authorised Service Facility for examination, repair, or electrical or mechanical adjustment.
- **10.** If the Supply Cord is damaged, it must be replaced by KitchenAid, its service agent or similarly qualified persons in order to avoid a hazard.
- **11.** Do not let Cord hang over edge of table or counter.
- **12.** Do not let the Cord contact hot surfaces, including the stove.
- **13.** Blades are sharp. Care should be taken when handling the sharp cutting Blades, emptying the jar, and during cleaning.
- **14.** Flashing light indicates ready to operate avoid any contact with Blades or moveable parts.
- **15.** When blending hot liquids or ingredients, Ingredient-Measuring Cap should remain in place over the Lid opening. Always start on lowest speed and slowly ramp to desired speed when blending hot liquids or ingredients.
- **16.** Keep hands and utensils out of jar while blending to reduce the risk of severe injury to persons or damage to the Blender. A scraper may be used but must be used only when the Blender is not running.
- 17. Do not use the appliance outdoors.
- **18.** Never leave the appliance unattended while it is in operation.

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- **19.** Be careful if hot liquid is poured into the Blender as it can be ejected out of the appliance due to sudden steaming.
- **20.** Always operate appliance with Lid in place.
- **21.** The use of accessories/attachments not recommended or sold by KitchenAid may cause fire, electric shock, or injury to persons.
- **22.** Allow the appliance to cool completely before putting on or taking off parts, and before cleaning the appliance.
- **23.** Refer to the "Care and Cleaning" section for instructions on cleaning the surfaces in contact with food.
- **24.** This appliance is intended to be used in household and similar applications such as:
 - staff kitchen areas in shops, offices and other working environments;
 - farmhouses;
 - by clients in hotels, motels and other residential type environments;
 - bed and breakfast type environments.

ELECTRICAL REQUIREMENTS

AWARNING

BLENDER FUNCTION GUIDE

The Blender has a preset recipe programme: Icy Drinks. It also features Variable Times and Pulse functions that allow you to customize your blending for any recipe you make.

SETTING	DESCRIPTION	BLENDING TIME (in min:sec)
B	Gradually ramp up to full power to completely blend hard foods such as ice, whole fruits or vegetables, or frozen fruits. This cycle is recommended for such drinks as margaritas, daiquiris, and blended ice coffee drinks.	0:22
•	When Low speed is selected, the Blender will run continuously on low until the DII (Start/Stop) Toggle Switch is pressed, or after 6 minutes elapse.	N/A
•	When Medium speed is selected, the Blender will run continuously on medium until the DII (Start/Stop) Toggle Switch is pressed, or until 6 minutes elapse.	N/A
•	When High speed is selected the Blender will run continuously on high until the \mathcal{D} II (Start/Stop) Toggle Switch is pressed, or after 6 minutes elapse.	N/A

To clean the Blender: Quick pulses of power and high speeds work to clean the Blender Jar with just 2 cups of water and a drop of dish soap.




Before first use

Before using your Blender for the first time, wipe the Blender Base with a warm, damp cloth, then wipe clean with a damp cloth. Dry with a soft cloth. Wash the Blender Jar, Lid, Flex Edge Tamper, and Ingredient-Measuring Cap in warm, sudsy water (see the "Care and Cleaning" section). Rinse parts and wipe dry.

1. Before using the Blender, be sure the countertop beneath the Blender and surrounding areas are dry and clean. Then, plug the Blender into an earthed outlet.



 The main Power Switch is on the back of the Blender Base. Flip the Power Switch to ON (I). The Status Indicator Light above the DII (Start/ Stop) Toggle Switch will begin to flash, indicating that the Blender is in Standby Mode. The Blender is now ready to operate.




PRODUCT USAGE

1. Put the items to blend into the Blender Jar. Add liquids first, then soft foods, then leafy greens, and ice or frozen items last.




NOTE: Do not fill Blender Jar past the topmost measurement mark, especially when blending liquids.


2. Make sure that the Lid is fully secured on the Blender Jar. Next, place the Blender Jar on the Base, making sure that it is fully aligned on the Jar Pad.



3. Turn the Control Dial to your desired speed, time, or programme. See the "Blender Function Guide" for more information.



4. Flip the ▷II (Start/Stop) Toggle Switch up or down to begin operation of the Blender. The Status Indicator Light will now be solid.




NOTE: If you select a pre-programmed cycle, you will need to flip the DII (Start/Stop) Toggle Switch to begin operation. The Blender will automatically stop running once the cycle is complete.

5. Utilize the Flex Edge Tamper accessory as needed for optimal blending performance. Remove the Ingredient-Measuring Cap only, and leave the Lid in place. Stir or press contents down towards the Blade. When you are finished, replace the Ingredient-Measuring Cap to the Blender Jar.




6. If desired, use the Pulse function for a momentary boost of speed while blending on the variable speed settings.

Press and Hold the Λ (Pulse) Toggle Switch up for a faster pulse, or down for a slower pulse.



NOTE: The Pulse function may also be used on its own as a separate blending function while the Blender is in Standby Mode. Pulse is not available when running a preset program.

7. After blending, flip the DII (Start/Stop) Toggle Switch up or down. Allow the Blender to come to a complete stop before removing the Lid and pouring your blended ingredients.




CARE AND CLEANING

CLEANING THE BLENDER AND ACCESSORIES


Clean the Blender thoroughly after every use.

NOTE: Allow the appliance to cool completely before putting on or taking off parts, and before cleaning the appliance. To avoid damaging the Blender, do not immerse the Blender Base or Cord in water. To avoid scratching the Blender, do not use abrasive cleansers or scouring pads.

1. To clean the Blender Base and Cord: Unplug the Blender before cleaning. Wipe the Base and the Cord with a warm, damp, soapy cloth; wipe clean with a damp cloth, and dry with a soft cloth.




2. Make sure to clean the Blender Jar, Lid, and Ingredient-Measuring Cap after each use. Remove any remaining contents from the Blender Jar. Fill 1/3 of the Blender Jar with warm water and add 1 drop of liquid detergent. Place the Lid on the Blender Jar, and make sure the Blender Jar is fully in place on the Blender Base.



3. Rotate the Control Dial to 30 seconds. Flip the DII (Start/Stop) Toggle Switch up or down. When the timer finishes, pour out the soapy water and rinse the Blender Jar with warm water.



4. The Blender Jar, Lid, Flex Edge Tamper, and Ingredient-Measuring Cap are dishwashersafe; the Flex Edge Tamper, Lid, and Ingredient- Measuring Cap should be placed in the top rack of the dishwasher. If preferred, all parts may also be washed by hand with a damp cloth and warm soapy water, and then rinsed with warm water and dried with a soft cloth.



TROUBLESHOOTING

AWARNING

PROBLEM	SOLUTION
When the Blender is plugged in and the I/O (main power ON/OFF) Toggle Switch is ON (I) , the Blender will go into Standby Mode (flashing white Indicator Light). However, after 10 minutes of no activity the Blender will go into Sleep mode and the Indicator Light will turn off.	To wake up the Blender, simply flip the DII Start/Stop Toggle Switch up or down. This will put the Blender back into Standby Mode.
If the Status Indicator Light flashes an orange colour, the Blender is in error mode. This can be caused by using a spatula in the Blender Jar that locks up the Blade or having an ice cube or hard food in a location that locks up the Blade.	Correct the problem by turning off (O) the Blender using the dedicated off switch in the back, or by unplugging the Blender. Remove the Blender Jar from the Base, and clear the items. Place the Blender Jar back on the Base, and then turn the Blender back on to continue regular use.
If the Blender stops while blending.	After 6 minutes of run time, the Blender will automatically shut off and go into Sleep mode, and the LED light will turn off. You can wake the Blender back up using the Toggle Switches DII (Start/Stop or Pulse High/Pulse Low). If the Blender stops in less than 6 minutes, it is possible there is an internal error with the Blender.
If the ingredients of a recipe aren't blending.	There may be times when an air pocket is created around the Blade, causing the ingredients to miss the blending Blade. Use your Flex Edge Tamper to assist during the blend by pushing ingredients into the Blade, or stir to move ingredients around the Blender Jar. If that does not work, stop the Blender, remove the Blender Jar from the Base, and use a spatula to rearrange ingredients in the Blender Jar. For certain recipes, try adding more liquid.
If you experience an overflow from the Blender Jar.	Unplug the Blender. Remove the Jar and Jar Pad. Clean the Blender housing, Jar Pad, and exterior of the Jar. Dry each part thoroughly, and then reinstall the Jar Pad.

PROBLEM	SOLUTION	
If you experience an overflow from the Blender Jar.	If the overflow is on or over the Control Dial, it can be removed by gently and firmly pulling it off. After cleaning and drying, reinstall the knob. To avoid damage to the graphics, do not apply too much force or use abrasive cleansers.	EN
If the problem cannot be corrected.	See the "Terms of KitchenAid Guarantee ("Guarantee")" sections. Do not return the Blender to the retailer; retailers do not provide service.

- b) The Guarantee period depends on the purchased product and is as follows:

One Year full guarantee from date of purchase.

- c) The Guarantee period commences on the date of purchase, i.e. the date on which a consumer purchased the product from a dealer or a company of the KitchenAid-Group.
- d) The Guarantee covers the defect-free nature of the product.
- e) The Guarantor shall provide the consumer with the following services under this Guarantee, at the choice of the Guarantor, if a defect occurs during the Guarantee period:
 - Repair of the defective product or product part, or
 - Replacement of the defective product or product part. If a product is no longer available, the Guarantor is entitled to exchange the product for a product of equal or higher value.

- h) To be able to make a claim under the Guarantee, the consumer must present the receipt or invoice of the purchase of the product.

2. LIMITATIONS OF THE GUARANTEE
